

2020 Dolores L. Peck Art Scholarship Guidelines

- The scholarship is open to all high school students in St. Joseph County, IN and in counties immediately adjacent to St. Joseph County, IN, including those in Michigan.
- Two winners will receive an award of \$750.
- This year's contest is open to visual art media (photography, painting, sculpture, collage, textile art, etc.). The contest is not open to most performing art, but original songs or music videos based on original songs will be accepted.
- Work must be submitted to the Right to Life Office or, if a digital piece, can be submitted as a .jpeg or .png file to prolifemichiana.org.
- Along with the submission of the original piece, an artist statement (no more than 250 words) is required explaining and interpreting the piece.
- Only one entry per student will be accepted and any submissions that are found to not be originals will be automatically disqualified.
- Entries must be received by 11:59pm on Monday, March 30th, 2020.
- Winners will be notified by Friday, April 17th, 2020.
- Winners are strongly encouraged to attend the Respect Life Prayer Dinner on Tuesday, April 21st, 2020 in South Bend. Complementary dinners will be provided to winners and their immediate family members.
- St. Joseph County Right to Life, Inc. reserves the right to publish and/or publicly read all or any portion of entries received. However, all entries will be returned to those who submitted them after the scholarship winner is chosen.

Artists must watch the movie "Unplanned" and then create a piece of fan art in response to the film. Art may be inspired by a theme, scene, or object within the film.
