

2021 Dolores L. Peck Art Scholarship Guidelines

- The scholarship is open to all high school students in St. Joseph County, Elkhart County, and all adjacent counties.
- Two winners will receive an award of \$750.
- This year's contest is open to visual art media (photography, painting, sculpture, collage, textile art, etc.) and performing art.
- Work must be submitted to the Right to Life Michiana Office or, if a digital piece or performance art recording, can be submitted as a .jpeg or .png file to programs@prolifemichiana.org.
- Along with the submission of the original piece, an artist statement (no more than 250 words) is required explaining and interpreting the piece.
- Only one entry per student will be accepted and any submissions that are found to not be originals will be automatically disqualified.
- Entries must be received or postmarked by April 30th.
- Winners will be notified by May 31st.
- Right to Life Michiana, Inc. reserves the right to publish and/or publicly read all or any portion of entries received. However, all entries will be returned to those who submitted them after the scholarship winner is chosen.
